In Elaia, composer Amir Swaab presents a series of character pieces for piano, violin, and cello. In these new compositions, tradition and innovation merge into original, timeless melodies. The works are poetic, atmospheric, and accessible, yet harmonically rich and layered.

The music is performed by Merel Vercammen (violin), Hadewych van Gent (cello), and Mattias Spee (piano) – three musicians known not only for their excellent playing and musical depth, but also for their independent path within the world of classical music.



Elaia is an unusual tribute to melody and harmony: new musical stories in a universal idiom. Music that does not aim to provoke, but to move; not to break down, but to build. Amir Swaab seeks connection, beauty, and expressive power – and in doing so, finds a future perspective in an ancient source.
